#### Planning Board

Established in 1944, the Planning Board is responsible for the Township Master Plan under standards defined in the NJ Municipal Land Use Law. The Board reviews and acts on applications for all major subdivisions, site plans (unless a use variance is involved) and bulk variances. The Board typically meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month at 8:00PM.

#### Zoning Board of Adjustment

The Board hears zoning variance applications and appeals from rulings and determinations arising from enforcement of township zoning ordinances, as well as interpreting current zoning for various applications as the need may arise. The Board typically meets the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 8:00PM.

#### **Environmental Commission**

The Commission is responsible for working with officials to educate the public and generate solutions to environmental issues. These include issues like energy conservation, waste reduction and recycling. The Commission is also responsible for commenting to the Planning and Zoning Boards about environmental issues. The Commission typically meets at 7:00PM on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of each month.

#### Historic Preservation Advisory Committee

Started in 1997, the Committee has the responsibility of developing ordinances for historic preservation, advising other government planning bodies about historic elements involved in proposed projects, and updating the Township's historic sites survey with an eye toward designating specific districts and sites as suitable for historic registration. The Committee typically meets the 1st Wednesday of each month at 7:30PM in town hall.

#### Open Space Advisory Committee

The Committees' mission is to recommend preservation of land for recreational, historical and agricultural purposes. They are responsible for implementing the townships Open Space programs and recommend applicable grants. The Committee typically meets the 1st Monday of each month at 7:30PM in town hall.

#### **Shade Tree Commission**

The role of the Commission is to advise the Township Committee on all matters pertaining to the planting and care of trees and shrubs on all public roads and parks. They also recommend programs and evaluate and recommend changes to planning/zoning ordinances. The Commission typically meets the last Monday of each month at 7:30PM.

#### Communications Advisory Committee

Started in 2007, the Committee is responsible for advising the township on matters pertaining to technology and media communications. The Committee typically meets the first Thursday of the month at 8pm.

#### **Library Board of Trustees**

The Trustees oversees, develops and analyzes policy for the Township Library. The Board of Trustees typically meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 7:30 PM at the Library.

#### Recreation Advisory Committee

The Committee is committed to providing a wide range of programs and leisure activities to the residents. The Committee recommends programs to the township, coordinates with recreational groups and handles other matters referred by the township. The Committee typically meets the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7:30pm.

#### **Beatification Committee**

Consisting of approximately seven members including business owners, the Committee assists in the beautification of the township and raises funds for these projects. Meetings are called as needed.
