

Dear Long Hill Residents:

Enclosed please find the Long Hill Emergency Information booklet. It contains important facts and phone numbers. Please read the materials provided <u>and register for Alert Long Hill</u>.

**Important Changes for Next Year -** Changes to garbage, recycling and bulk collection **will occur on January 1**<sup>st</sup> **2021**. Information is also available on the Township website at <a href="www.longhillnj.gov">www.longhillnj.gov</a> and in the Town Planner calendar.

**Recycling** - The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority will collect and dispose of household recyclable materials. Enclosed is a sticker for your recycling bin as well as a flyer detailing acceptable and unacceptable items for recycling. PLEASE NOTE THAT RECYCLING WILL BE COLLECTED ON EVERY OTHER **MONDAY IN ALL ZONES** BEGINNING ON JANUARY 4, 2021. Collection days are listed below. (See the calendar for holidays and make-up collection days).

**Garbage -** The Township has entered into a contract with Grand Sanitation for the collection and disposal of solid waste beginning on January 1, 2021. <u>NOTE:</u> Collection day and zone will remain the same. Holidays and make-up collection days are listed in the Town Planner calendar and on the Township website.

**Scrap Metal/Appliance/Electronics** - Pickup will take place every other month during the weeks listed below. Your collection day during these weeks is the same day of the week as your garbage collection. **Note:** These items can be brought to DPW any time during regular business hours.

**Bulk Collection -** Will take place every other month during the dates below on the same day as garbage collection. You may place only **TWO ITEMS** at the curb for collection in each of the months.

**Compost** - Branches, Grass, and Leaves may be dropped off at the Department of Public Works yard on the Saturdays below during the hours of 8 am and 12 pm (Oct, Nov, Dec: 8 am-1 pm). Building Materials may be dropped off on the circled day (see calendar for acceptable materials).
